- U/6 moulded sole football boots or soft sole sandshoes. No metal studs.
- U/7 moulded sole football boots. No metal studs or sports shoes.
- U/8 & older - moulded sole or studded football boots. No sports shoes.
- No baseball cleats to be worn at any time.
